Well maintained tools are available to use during the class for each student.



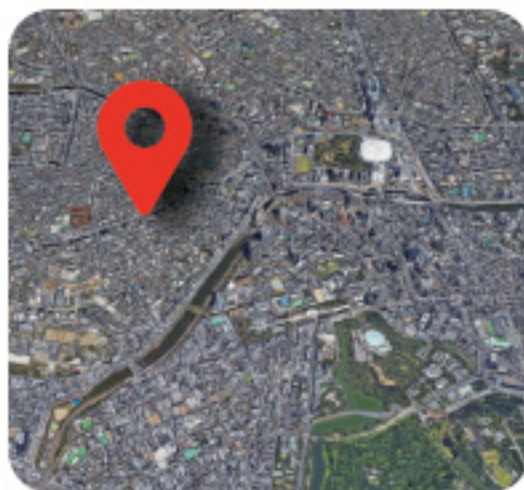
Use furniture grade lumber

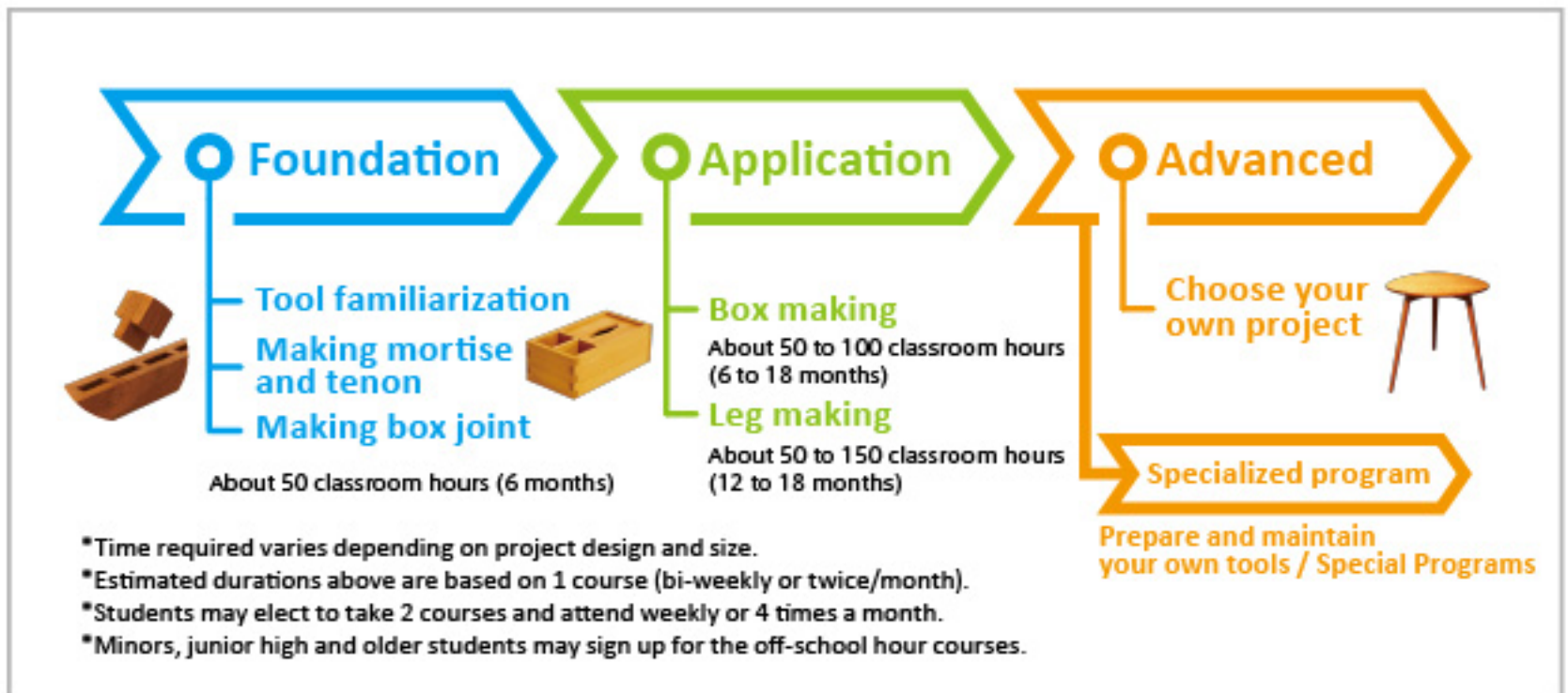
